Post-Season Tournament Rules

 \rightarrow During tournament play there are no pitching limitations on outs or innings for any divisions.

- Any player may pitch unlimited innings including girls who did not evaluate as pitchers.
- \rightarrow No player will sit twice before every player has sat once.
 - Exception **BEFORE** each game managers will report to the umpire, scorekeeper and opposing coach a player who will be exempt from having to sit during that game.

→ During the end of season tournament the highest ranked team, based on regular season win/loss record, will be Home team during play in the winners' bracket. During Loser Bracket play, home team will be determined by which team is positioned at the top of the bracket. During Championship and If Game scenario, a coin flip will be conducted before start of game to determine Home/Visitor. The higher seeded team (at start of tournament) will occupy the 3rd base dugout.

→ Normal time limits apply for each age division. (except for first championship game). During tournament play 8U will not have a drop dead rule. International Tie Breakers will be used in the event of a tie score at the end of regulation. This includes the second (if) championship game.

 \rightarrow 8u championship game will be no new inning will start after 1 hour and 45 min and a maximum of 6 innings.

 \rightarrow 10u championship game will be a 6 inning game with no time limit.

 \rightarrow 12u, 14u, & 16u championship game will be a 7 inning game with no time limit.

→ Any further rule clarifications will adhere to the current year ASA rule book
