## Post-Season Tournament Rules

 $\rightarrow$  No pitch limit restrictions will be used during tournament week playoff games. No pitch limit restrictions apply in Championship games.

→ No player will sit twice before every player has sat once.

• Exception - **BEFORE** each game managers with report to the umpire and scorekeeper the **player** who will be exempt from having to sit during that game.

→ During the end of season tournament the highest ranked team, based on regular season win/loss record (first tie breaker head to head record, second tie breaker less points scored against, third tie breaker higher points scored differential), will be Home team during play in the winners' bracket. During Loser Bracket play, home team will be determined by which team is positioned at the top of the bracket. During Championship the undefeated team will be the home team and will occupy the third base dugout. In the event of an "IF" game, the away team from the prior game will become the home team for the "IF" game. Teams will occupy the same dugouts as prior game.

→ Normal time limits apply for each age division. (except for first championship game and IF game). During tournament play 8U will not have a drop dead rule. International Tie Breakers will be used in the event of a tie score at the end of regulation. This includes the second (if) championship game.

 $\rightarrow$  8u championship game and IF game will be no new inning will start after 1 hour and 45 min and a maximum of 6 innings.

- $\rightarrow$  10u championship game and IF game will be a 6 inning game with no time limit.
- $\rightarrow$  12u, 14u, & 16u championship game and IF game will be a 7 inning game with no time limit.
- → Any further rule clarifications will adhere to the current year ASA rule book
