

SNACK BAR VOLUNTEER POLICY

The Menifee Girls Softball Association is a non-profit all volunteer organization that relies solely on its volunteers to help run the league snack bar. Parents or an approved representative must work one, one-hour snack bar shift per player at any time during the current softball season. Team managers are exempt from snack bar commitments for their child/player they manage. Assistant coaches and team moms are not included in this exemption.

A \$100 snack bar volunteer deposit is required to be paid by all parents prior to Opening Day of the current softball season. Deposits can be made in cash, check, or via Zelle. Checks must be made payable to **Menifee Girls Softball** (no abbreviations). Zelle payments can be sent to **treasurer@menifeeasa.com**. All deposits must indicate which division, player last name, and team the deposit is for (i.e., 8U - Coldwater - UCLA).

The team mom is responsible for ensuring all parents have provided their deposit and that the money is turned into the league snack bar coordinator. All deposits will be held by the league treasurer until the snack bar commitment is fulfilled. Checks will be returned on the day of the snack bar shift. Cash and Zelle payments will be paid within 3 to 5 working days.

If a volunteer is a "No-Show" for their scheduled shift and has not taken the responsibility to find a replacement or advise the snack bar coordinator of an absence, they will forfeit their deposit.

Snack Bar Sign Up: Sign up opportunities will be available once games schedules have been posted. Availability of snack bar shifts are first come first serve. Please note, a 24-hour notification is required for any shift changes and should be arranged with the snack bar coordinator via email at **snackbar@menifeeasa.com**.

Rain Outs: All rain out snack bar days must be rescheduled for a later date. These dates could fall during regular season or during playoffs. Arrangements should be made with and approved by the snack bar coordinator.

Teen Volunteers: Teens 16 years and older are allowed to work as snack bar volunteers and must be able to work with and communicate well with adults. Any teen under 18 will not be allowed to use the grill. Teens may also use their volunteer time to satisfy community service hours. However, this must be approved by and coordinated through the snack bar coordinator.
